**A RESOLUTION OF THE MILLERSVILLE, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO  
ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION OF COMMISSIONER TOMMY LONG  
AND DECLARING A COMMISSIONER VACANCY ON

**WHEREAS**, Article 6-20-110 of the Millersville private act charter stipulates that a vacancy shall exist on the Board of Commissioners if Commissioner resigns or moves their residence from the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Tommy Long has advised the Board of Commissioners that he has resigned his position on The Board of Commissioners for the City of Millersville effective January 22, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, Commissioner Tommy Long has submitted his oral resignation to the Millersville Board of Commissioners, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Millersville Board of Commissioners respectfully wishes to accept the resignation submitted by Commissioner Tommy Long.

**Now, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners that the City of Millersville, Tennessee as Follows:

I. The resignation of Commissioner Tommy Long from the Board of Commissioners of the City of Millersville, Tennessee is hereby accepted.

II. The Board of Commissioners hereby declares the Commissioner seat formerly held by Tommy Long to be vacant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, That this Resolution shall become effective upon its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
