

**Proclamation**  
**National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week**  
**April 13-19, 2025**

Whereas emergencies can occur at any time that require police, fire, or emergency medical services; and,

Whereas when an emergency occurs the prompt response of police officers, firefighters and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and,

Whereas the safety of our police officers and firefighters is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who telephone the Sumner County Emergency Communications Center; and,

Whereas Public Safety Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and,

Whereas Public Safety Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information, and ensuring their safety; and,

Whereas Public Safety Telecommunicators of the Millersville Community have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and,

Whereas each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year;

Therefore, Be it proclaimed the City Council of Millersville declares the week of April 13-19, 2025 to be National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in Millersville, in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our city and citizens safe.
